On 26 June 2013 the Government published the consultation conclusions on its key legislative proposals for the establishment of an independent Insurance Authority (IIA). The establishment of the IIA and the provision for a new statutory licensing regime for insurance intermediaries are described by the Government as “the most significant reform initiative for the insurance industry since the passage of the Insurance Companies Ordinance in 1983”.

This is an opportunity to hear the **Commissioner of Insurance** on the proposed regulatory changes:

- The establishment of the IIA
- The licensing of insurance intermediaries
- Conduct requirements on insurance intermediaries
- The IIA’s regulatory powers
- Appointment of Responsible Officers (ROs)
- Regulatory arrangements for banks’ insurance activities:
- Transitional arrangements.

Annie Choi joined the Hong Kong Government in 1986. She has worked in a number of policy bureaux and departments, including the Home Affairs Department, Civil Service Bureau, Health and Welfare Bureau, Innovation and Technology Commission, as well as the Environment, Transport and Works Bureau.
