Prof. Merkin is the Lloyd's Law Reports Chair of Commercial Law at the University of Southampton, Consultant to Norton Rose and an advisor to the English and Scottish Law Commissions for their inquiry into the reform of insurance law.

Prof. Merkin edits the Journal of Business Law, Insurance Law Monthly and Arbitration Law Monthly and co-edits the Lloyd's Law Reports and Legal Studies. He has also written some 40 books on insurance, reinsurance and arbitration, which include the UK and Hong Kong editions of Colinaux's Law of Insurance and Arnould on Marine Insurance; his writings are regularly cited in English and other common law courts as works of authority, citations to date include the High Court of Australia and the US Supreme Court.

Prof. Merkin regularly gives expert evidence in judicial proceedings and arbitrations in a variety of jurisdictions, as well as appearing as an advocate in arbitrations and sitting as an arbitrator.
